Come spend some time at Schramm's Farm this summer and participate in our 8-week series of hands-on science and nature courses for children ages 3-10 years old. We'll get our hands dirty and keep our bodies and minds active as we explore, investigate and discover the amazing natural world of the farm and the science involved with growing fruits and vegetables.

**Week 1: Let's Get Growing!**

June 4th - 5th

Before there can be a harvest, there must be a planting! In this first class, Sprouts will sow seeds, plant plants that will grow and blossom throughout the summer under proper care. Sprouts will also learn about the growing process and take home at least one plant of their own to start their gardening adventure at home too! It's so exciting, we may even wet our plants!

**\*\*Sprouts should come ready & dressed to dig in the dirt.\*\***

**Week 2: Great Garden Friends**

June 11th - 12th

Scarecrows, Bees and Lady Bugs have long been friends of the farmer and gardener alike! Sprouts will learn about the benefits of these three garden helpers, while each class builds it's own group scarecrow, each Sprout will build their own bee house and discover the big job of the tiny ladybug! The class scarecrows will be used in a special display in October during the Schramm Fall Festival!

**Week 3: This Class will be "Legend-Dairy!"**

June 18th - 19th

Celebrate National Dairy Month as Sprouts will become Dairy Kings and Queens this week when we explore all things dairy farming! We'll learn everything from cows to ice-cream, how milk "does the body good" and all the things dairy farms produce! Sprouts will be "moo-ers" and shakers as we make real milkshakes! It's guaranteed to be "Udder-ly a-Moo-sing!"

**Week 4: Dirt + Water = MUD!**

June 25th - 26th

It's simple math: Add water to dirt and you get MUD! Did you know it also equals fun? Sprouts will discover both the fun and practicality of this famous mixture. Not only can mud build roads and make art, but also form bricks to build with and be instrumental to help plants grow! Learning is a dirty job, but someone's gotta do it!

July 16th - 17th

Look in the sky! Is it a plane? Is it Superman? It's a BIRD! Not as powerful as a locomotive, not faster than a speeding bullet, but still able to fly over tall buildings, birds are quite amazing creatures! Sprouts will discover what it's like to build a nest and creative ways to attract and feed our fine feathered friends. This class is truly for the birds!

**Week 7: Nature Art and Happy Little Trees**

July 23rd - 24th

Art is everywhere and in everything. All it takes is a little imagination and creativity to bring it out! Sprouts will create masterpieces using tools and mediums provided by Mother Nature. Whether your child is a surrealist, impressionist, post modernist or abstract artist, they will love finding their inner Bob Ross in this class! Several projects will be created and taken home.
